4.3 Refunds

The entry fee will be refunded in full:

- a. To candidates whose entry has not been accepted
- b. In the case of the rally not taking place

5 SERVICE PARK

5.1 Number and location

- There will be 1 main Service Park & 1 Remote Service locations for the duration of the Baja.
- The Service Park is placed in Old Port Aqaba. (GPS: N29° 30'45.82' – E34° 59'48.57")
- Remote Service is located in Wadi Rum (GPS: N29° 38.140' E35° 30.833')
- Service can be done only inside Service parks.

5.2 Access times for service vehicles

- The service vehicles will be allowed to enter the Service Parks at the latest 1 hour before the entry time of the 1st car scheduled in the timing.

5.3 Assistance between FIA competitors still in the race is permitted in all the Baja.

5.4 Fuel/Refuel.

- Their no limit on how much fuel a vehicle may carry.
- No fuel may be carried on board the vehicle in containers that are not plumbed to the vehicle fuel system and mounted securely.
- In the Service Park it is forbidden to refuel.
- Refuelling is permitted only in the designated commercial fuel stations, using fuel on sale to the public. Only the crew may carry out this procedure.
- The fuel stations authorized will be indicated in the Road Book with "FUEL STATION".

5.5 General Regulations for Service

5.5.1 Service and repairs are permitted only if carried out in all the route (including the Selective Sections):

- By the crew of the concerned car
- By the crews of another entered vehicle still in the race.

5.5.2 In the service area, only three team personnel may work on a competing vehicle. They will be identified by a distinctive armband supplied by the organizer (Colour: Yellow) (Article 30.14 FIA CCR GP 2019).

- 5.5.3** The “SERVICE” / “AUXILIARY” / “TRUCK” Plates must be affixed to the authorized vehicles. During the Baja, no vehicle will be permitted to enter the Service Park unless these plates are affixed. Inside the Service Park the staff charged by the Competitors must wear their wristband (Colour: Yellow) supplied by the Organizers during administrative checks in a very visible way.

5.6 Infractions of the Service and Refuelling rules - Penalties

All the infractions of the Service and Refuelling rules reported by the Judges of Fact or by other Officials will involve a penalty that will be decided by the Stewards of the Meeting and that can go as far as the disqualification from the race.

5.7 Environmental Mat

Inside the service areas and the Parc Fermé at the end of LEG 1 and LEG 2 (Aqaba Service Park) competitors are obliged to lay under their cars a proper environmental mat to avoid the discharge of liquids on the soil. Otherwise, the Clerk of the Course will report to the stewards against the car's team.

5.8 Garbage Bins

Inside the Service Park, there are bins for garbage. In case of not cleaning of the service area during and at the end of the race, the Clerk of the Course will award a penalty of 100 Euro to the competitor who has registered the car.

6 TYRES / FUEL

6.1 Tyres:

In accordance with Article 10 of the 2021 FIA CCRSR & Article 10 of Appendix V2 of the 2021 FIA CCRSR.

T1 Priority drivers are allowed a maximum of 8 tyres for all the Baja.

6.2 Fuel

- All types of fuel must follow Appendix J Art. 252.9. (Art. 57 of the FIA CCRSR).
- Refuel stations are marked on the Road Book, competitors are obliged to refuel in these stations only.
- Fuel available in these stations is Diesel, Gasoline 90 and 95 octane.
- A bulletin will be published to indicate type and grade of fuel in these stations.

7 IMPORTING VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

All foreign Competitors must report at the customs when crossing borders. All vehicles must have a valid carnet and a detailed packing list of all spare parts and tools. At every border, a representative from Aramex will be there to assist and finalize all paper work.

It is preferable if all details, including packing lists are sent to the Organiser as soon as possible. The information must include vehicles' details, date and border point of entry. All information to be conveyed to info@jordanrally.com or faxed to the Organiser and a copy emailed to Aramex at tawfeek.hijazi@aramex.com. This will speed up the process of producing the customs declaration documents.

At the Aqaba Service Park, a representative from the Customs Department and a representative from Aramex will be available for the whole duration of the Event and will check that all papers are in good order before the cars leave the Service Park.

8 HOSPITALITY ARRANGEMENTS

8.1 Hospitality and Tourism

For Jordan Baja Teams, Officials and Guests, a separate entrance at the Rally HQ will operate in the Hyatt convention centre beside the hotel. The Rally Office will operate from Wednesday, March 17th, 2021 to Saturday, March 20th, 2021.

The official hotel of the rally is Hyatt in Ayla Aqaba.

The Ceremonial Start offers excellent facilities for hospitality on Thursday afternoon; Spectators will enjoy a local, varied entertainment program featuring Q&A with the drivers.

Spectators will have a selection of opportunities to join the action on our exciting Special Stages on Friday and Saturday.

The Baja will reach its climax on Saturday afternoon with the end of Rally and Finish Podium celebrations at Aqaba Service Park in the old port Aqaba.

10 RECONNAISSANCE

In accordance with Article 24 of the 2021 FIA Cross-Country Regulations.

11 SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

11.1 Venue and Timetable

11.1.1 Venue

- The Scrutineering venue is at the Aqaba Service Park in the old port Aqaba.
- Layout Diagram is available in Appendix 20.2.

11.1.2 Timetable

- Thursday, March 18th, 2021 between 09:00 and 13:00hrs.
- Cars Individual times will be announced in a Bulletin.
- A representative of the Team may present the car at Scrutineering.

11.2 Vehicles Presentation:

Vehicles must be present at Scrutineering within 45 minutes following the Administrative Checks. A Time Control (AS2) before Scrutineering entrance, Cars Individual times will be announced in a Bulletin, any delay greater than 30 minutes will incur a 100 Euro penalty.

11.3 Documents to be presented:

- FIA Group T Homologation form for T1,2,3,4
- FIA Technical Passport for all the vehicles
- ASN Technical Passport for National competitors
- Original Certificate form for the Rollcage and Fuel tanks

11.4 Drivers equipment:

Helmets, head restraint (HANS) and flame-resistant clothing will be checked at Scrutineering.

11.5 Windscreen:

In case the windscreen is absent due to an accident, at the start of a Leg, the wearing of a full-face helmet with a visor or goggles of motocross type, or an open face helmet with motocross type of goggles is compulsory for all members of the crew, otherwise the vehicle will not be permitted to start the Leg.

11.6 Installation of Safety Tracking System

All competitors must make provision in their cars/motorcycles for the installation of the tracking & emergency system. Installation instructions will be provided in Appendix IV. The correct functioning and installation of the equipment will be checked at Scrutineering.

A deposit of **€300** will be collected before receiving any unit on Thursday, March 18th, 2021 during Administrative Checks. Should a crew retire, the equipment must be returned immediately to the suppliers of the units. The units may be removed in the Final Parc Fermé, so cars must not be locked.

11.7 Final Scrutineering

Final Scrutineering will take place at the Scrutineering Venue – Aqaba Old port. Cars will be escorted to the Scrutineering venue.

12 START PROCEDURE

12.1 Jordan Baja Ceremonial Start

- The Ceremonial Start will take place in Aqaba on Thursday, March 18th, 2021 starting at 19:00hrs, it is mandatory to attend by all competitors. We advise the fans and supporting people to be 1 hour in advance as there is an entertainment plan.
- Competitors reporting late to the Ceremonial start will be penalized with 30JD per minute a maximum of 30 minutes. Thereafter, they will be reported to the Stewards who may apply penalties at their discretion.
- The Ceremonial start holding will be secured. Access is limited to Crew members and Media representatives carrying the appropriate identification \ accreditation.
- The Ceremonial start will be in ascending car number order, starting from the first competitor to the last.
- Cars will start at One (1) minute interval.

12.2 Leg 1 – Start, Friday March 19th, 2021, Procedure:

- Cars will start from “TC 0” Parc Fermé OUT.

12.3 Leg 2 – Start, Saturday March 20th, 2021, Procedure:

- Cars will start from “TC 2C” Parc Fermé OUT.

12.4 Finish Procedure

- The rally will finish at “TC 3B” Finish Holding IN; thereafter crews must follow the instructions of the officials during the Podium Ceremony. From the Podium, Crews will immediately drive to Final Parc Fermé.
- Between “TC 3B” and Final Parc Fermé, cars are under Parc Fermé conditions and will be observed by marshals.

12.5 Permitted Early Check In

Crews may check in early without incurring a penalty at the following control:

- TC 1B End of Leg 1 \ Parc Fermé IN
- TC 2B End of Leg 2 \ Parc Fermé IN
- TC 3B End of Leg 3 \ Finish Holding IN

12.6 Official time used during the rally

Official time throughout the entire Rally will be that of GPS (UTC time +3 hours).

12.7 Selective Section Timing

- Selective Sections will be timed to the elapsed minute.
- The starting system in selective sections is as follows:
 - The marshal will register the start time on the time card;
 - The marshal will show the remaining time: 2 minutes, 1 minute and 30 seconds to the competitor with hand signals;
 - 10 seconds before the start the marshal will point to the start clock, which is displaying the current minute and second;
 - 5 seconds before the start (at --:55 seconds) the sequence will initiate:
 - 5 red LED segments turn on second by second on the bottom of the display clock;
 - At “0” seconds the LED's turn to green - this is the start signal. Starting before this (while the LED's are red) is considered as a jump start and will be penalized.

12.8 Start Intervals

All cars will start at **3 minutes'** intervals.

12.9 Time card change during the rally:

The Time Cards will be issued at the following time controls:

- Section 1 TC 0 Start Leg 1/Section 1
- Section 2 TC 1C Start Section 2/Leg 1 – Regrouping Out
- Section 3 TC 2C Start Section 3/Leg 2 – Parc Fermé Out

When retiring, the crew is obliged to hand their time card either to the next time control or otherwise to the Sweep car.

14.4 Pre-Rally Press Conference

The Press Conference, scheduled on Thursday, March 18th, 2021 will take place in the area of the Ceremonial Start.

The required drivers will be contacted by members of the media office team.

14.5 Post-Rally Press Conference

This will take place within one hour after the finish podium and winners' photo session. Members of the media team will be on hand to liaise with the winning drivers and co-drivers.

14.6 Expected coverage

With the Baja representing an exciting new chapter for Jordan Motorsport, we can expect strong local and regional coverage, as well as the international motorsport media showing an interest in how the event takes shape. Extensive written media coverage is expected in both the English and Arabic media with distribution reaching thousands of media contacts worldwide.

Jordan Television and Roya TV will send teams to cover, while a number of regional broadcasters have shown an interest and are expected to attend or receive footage.

The event radio partners; Hala 102.1 and Bliss 104.3 will be based at the Aqaba Service Park.

14.7 Media Safety

We do acknowledge that the Media play an important role in our events and that each member must be permitted to carry out his or her duty in the best possible surroundings. However, they are not exempted from having to respect safety regulations. In general, this should not interfere with their ability to perform their duties. Nevertheless, safety will always take priority. Such is the open nature of the Baja and this being the first one in Jordan, we request that our media colleagues pay special attention to our marshals' advice and orders this year and take extra safety precautions themselves.

15 MEDICAL AND SAFETY SERVICES

A Medical Centre will be located in Wadi Rum Remote Service GPS N29° 38.140' ,E35° 30.833'

The Organisers of Jordan Baja have developed a medical and safety system based on a hospital network that will be on alert all throughout the Rally, and on the accurate coordination of emergency vehicles and ambulances.

The comprehensive network will provide health assistance to both crews and spectators. The team consists of several first intervention vehicles (FIV) and Ambulances based at the start of Special Stages and other critical locations in the stages.

Four safety and medical helicopters stationed near Bait Ali Camp will provide assistance in difficult to reach areas and be ready to transfer injured patients. Qualified doctors and specially trained assistants are on board every vehicle. Nearby hospitals are on alert and the medical helicopters will fly to larger hospitals in Aqaba or Amman if needed.


